Why We Conducted These Procedures

We performed agreed-upon procedures in accordance with Attestation Standards to assist the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) in evaluating the documentation submitted by sub-grantees and technical assistance contractors (Documentation) to GOHSEP for reimbursement under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. For the period July 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023, we performed procedures on Documentation for reimbursement requests totaling \$23,329,696.


Of the \$23,329,696 in reimbursement requests, we found exceptions totaling \$3,355,763 (14.38%) as follows:

- \$51,369 (1.53%) related to out-of-scope expenses.
- \$3,063,174 (91.28%)
 related to expenses
 that lacked supporting
 documentation.
- \$241,220 (7.19%) related to unsupported procurement.

GOHSEP worked with the sub-grantees to resolve \$5,386,954 of exceptions from the current and prior reporting periods.

What We Found
