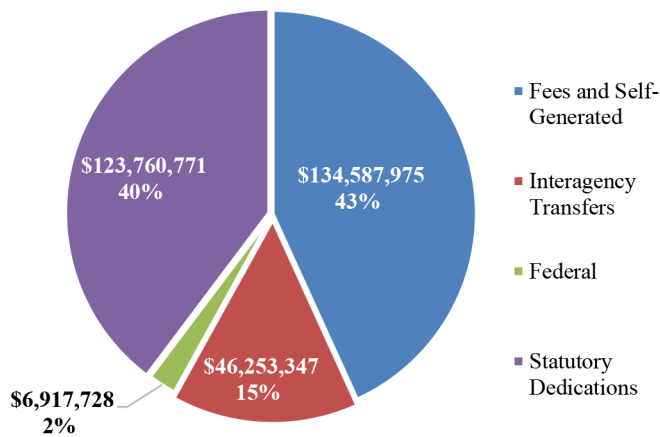
Why We Conducted This Audit

We performed certain procedures at the Office of State Police (OSP) as a part of the 2020 Single Audit of the State of Louisiana.

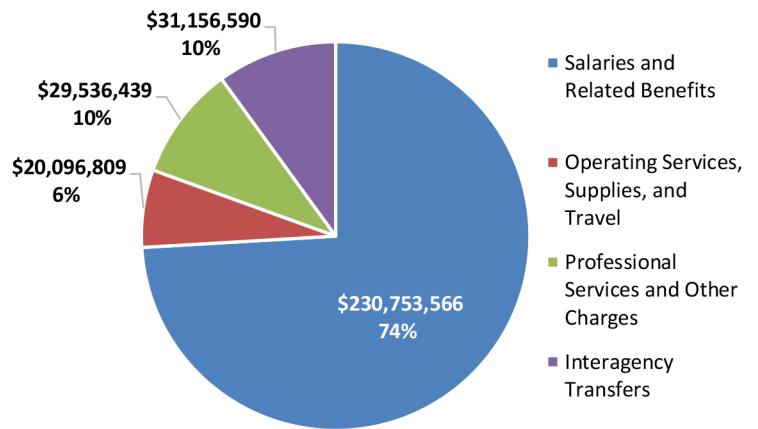
What We Found

- We performed internal control and compliance testing at OSP on the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CFDA 21.019), which is a major federal program for fiscal year 2020.
- Based on the results of these procedures, we did not report any findings.
- As shown below, we prepared an analysis of OSP’s revenues and expenditures during state fiscal year 2020. OSP recorded \$230,753,566 of expenditures for costs associated with salaries and related benefits. Of this amount, \$30,028,106, or approximately 13%, was funded with Coronavirus Relief Fund monies received through the Governor’s Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness as an interagency transfer.
