INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

Board of Trustees University of Louisiana at Monroe Foundation

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the University of Louisiana at Monroe Foundation (a nonprofit organization – the Foundation) which comprise the statements of financial position as of June 30, 2014 and 2013, and the related statements of activities and cash flows for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the financial statements as a whole.

Non-cash transactions during the years ended June 30, 2014 and 2013 consist of contributions of \$15,609 and \$52,851, respectively.

Cash paid for interest during the year ending June 30, 2014 and 2013 totaled \$0 and \$247, respectively.

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Organization

The University of Louisiana at Monroe Foundation (the Foundation) is a legally autonomous fund-raising organization that raises funds for the benefit of the University of Louisiana at Monroe (the University), its faculty and its students. Support is received through gifts, grants and bequests, and may include cash, real property and personal property. Funds may be invested by the Foundation in accordance with its investment policy subject to any restrictions imposed by the donor. Disbursements are made for scholarships, academic support and departmental funding.

The Foundation is a nonprofit corporation exempted from Federal income taxes as "other than a private foundation" under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation has evaluated its position regarding the accounting for uncertain income tax positions and does not believe that it has any material uncertain tax positions. The Foundation is no longer subject to examination by tax authorities for years ended before June 30, 2011.

Basis of Presentation

The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and in conformity as required by the *Not-For-Profit Entities* Topic of the Accounting Standards Codification (the Codification).

Financial Statement Classification

Classifications

The net assets of the Foundation are reported as follows:

- 1. Unrestricted includes all resources to be used in support of the Foundation's operations at the sole discretion of the Foundation.
- 2. Temporarily Restricted includes amounts that have been donated for the use of specific University departments, organizations or other beneficiaries. The donations and earnings, if any, are held by the Foundation until requested by the applicable department, organization or beneficiaries and may not be spent at the discretion of the Foundation. Also included are funds to provide interest-free loans to pharmacy students and persons with medical careers.
- 3. Permanently Restricted represents amounts contributed to the Foundation that are subject to restrictions imposed by the gift

instruments. Contributions to endowment funds are not available for use during the term of the applicable trust agreement. However, the Foundation's investment and spending policies provide for a specified amount of the earnings from such funds to be available for scholarships or for expenses of designated departments of the University as specified by the individual agreements. Unspent earnings are reflected under Temporarily Restricted Net Assets in the Statement of Financial Position and under the Endowment Income column in the Statement of Activities.

Contributions and Promises to Give

In accordance with the Revenue Recognition subtopic of the Not-For-Profit Entities Topic of the Codification, contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support depending on the existence or nature of any donor-imposed restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted or temporarily restricted, as appropriate, and reported in the Statement of Activities as net assets released from restrictions. Contributions are recognized as support when received or when an unconditional promise to give is received. However, all contributions received that qualify for matching from the State are recorded as increases in the liability, Funds Held as Agent, and are not reported on the Statement of Activities.

Unconditional promises to give are recognized as revenue in the period received. Promises to give are recorded at their realizable value if they are expected to be collected in one year and at their fair value of they are expected to be collected in more than one year. Conditional promises to give are recognized only when the conditions on which they depend are substantially met and the promises become unconditional. An allowance for doubtful accounts has been established based on management's assessment of collectability.

Donated Services and Materials

Noncash donations include both materials and services. These donations are recorded at their fair market value on the date of donation. Donated services are recognized only when they create or enhance a nonfinancial asset, or when they are specialized skills provided by entities or persons possessing those skills that would be purchased if they were not donated.

Allocation of Expenses

The costs of providing the various programs and other activities have been summarized between Program and Supporting Services in the Statement of Activities. Program Services expenses are those directly related to the various programs. Supporting Services expenses reflect other expenses incurred in operating the programs.

Property and Equipment

The Foundation capitalizes acquisitions of property and equipment with unrestricted funds in excess of \$1,000 or the fair market value on the date of donation. Costs of property and equipment purchased with unrestricted funds that are less than \$1,000 are charged to expense. The cost of these assets that is classified as program services expense is not capitalized by the Foundation as these assets are owned and used by departments of the University of Louisiana at Monroe. Acquisitions of these assets with restricted private donations are also not capitalized by the Foundation as these assets belong to the State of Louisiana. Capitalized assets are carried at cost or, if donated, at the approximate fair value at the date of donation. Depreciation is recorded on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of the assets. The Foundation utilizes estimated useful lives of 5 to 7 years for farm equipment and office equipment and 20 years for buildings. Depreciation of \$38,694 and \$40,776 for 2014 and 2013, respectively, was charged to expense.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

For Statement of Cash Flows purposes, the Foundation considers all highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

The Foundation, at times, may have deposits in excess of FDIC insured limits. Management, however, believes the credit risk associated with these deposits is minimal.

Accounting Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

The unconditional promises to give due in more than one year are reflected at the present value of estimated future cash flows using a discount rate for June 30, 2014 and 2013 of 5% for both years.

These unconditional promises to give are reported net of an allowance for uncollectible amounts. The allowance for uncollectible amounts as of June 30, 2014 and 2013 total \$0 and \$0, respectively.

Note 3 - Kitty P. DeGree Unitrust

In 1984, the Kitty P. DeGree Charitable Remainder Unitrust was established naming the Foundation as benefactor. The Trust was administered by a financial

institution. Kitty P. DeGree is to receive from the Unitrust an annual sum in the amount of the lesser of the Unitrust income for the year or 10% of the net fair market value of the assets.

Ms. DeGree died in October, 2012; at that time, the assets of the Unitrust were bequeathed to the Foundation in the amount of \$2,094,497 which reverted to the Foundation's unrestricted net assets in fiscal year 2014.

Note 4 - Land

The Helen Spyker Estate, which consists of farmland, timberland, and oil and gas reserves, is included in unrestricted net assets along with other parcels at June 30, 2014 and 2013 as follows:

Permanently restricted net assets include the Cloverleaf Simmental Farm, which was donated to the Foundation in December 1985. It is reflected in the Statements of Financial Position at its carrying value at \$3,137,317. The Foundation is required to use the majority of the farm acreage for agricultural and educational purposes until 2015.

Permanently restricted net assets also include a piece of property in Columbia, Louisiana, which was donated to the Foundation in April 2001. It is reflected in the Statements of Financial Position for its appraised value of \$58,000.

Note 5 - Investments

All investments in equity securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are reported at fair value with gains and losses included in the Statement of Activities. Fair Value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 6 for further discussion of fair value measurements.

The Foundation has adopted investment and spending policies which are reviewed peiodically. Within these policies there exists two distinct portions. The first portion is based upon the Louisiana Board of Regents Endowed Chairs / Endowed Professorship / Endowed Scholarship Programs Statement of Investment Policy

and Objectives. This portion limits the equity to no more than 74% of the asset allocation and fixed income to at least 26%. The other limitions include that no more than 10% are in hedge funds, 10% in REITS, and 15% in international investments, which are all part of the equity portion. The second portion is the endowment portion which is based upon a total return philosphy which currently has asset allocation targets of 75% in equites and 25% in fixed income. Within the equity portion the allocation includes 22% in international and 10% in hedge funds.

Return Objectives and Risk Parameters

The Foundation has adopted investment and spending policies for endowment assets that attempt to provide a predictable stream of funding to programs supported by its endowment while seeking to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment assets. Endowment assets include those assets of donor-restricted funds that the Foundation must hold in perpetuity. Under this policy, as approved by the Board of Trustees, the endowment assets are invested in a manner that is intended to produce results that exceed price and yield results of the S&P 500 index while assuming a moderate level of investment risk. The Foundation expects its endowment funds, over time, to provide an average rate of return of approximately 7.5 percent to 8.0 percent annually. Actual returns in any given year may vary from this amount.

Strategies Employed for Achieving Objectives

To satisfy its long-term rate-of-return objectives, the Foundation relies on a total return strategy in which investment returns are achieved through both capital appreciation (realized and unrealized) and current yield (interest and dividends).

The Foundation targets a diversified assets allocation that places a greater emphassis on equity-based investments to achieve its long-term return objectives within prudent risk constraints. The Foundation invests in multi-strategy hedge funds of funds. The investments are a sophisticated, multi-manager program designed to achieve an optimal balance of upside return potential and downside protection. The investments offer a diversified strategy protecting and preserving the Foundation's capital and providing long-term capital growth. This strategy also works to deliver risk-adjusted returns by capturing the market's return potential but with much less volatility. The portfolios are constructed using a time tested, disciplined methodology focused first on risk management. The funds have a demonstrated track record of maintaining a highly disciplined and effective investment allocation decision process. The returns from these hedge funds are reported and posted monthly reflecting the fair market value as of the

reporting date.

Spending Policy and How the Investment Objectives Relate to Spending Policy

The Foundation has a policy of appropriating for distribution each year 4 percent of its endowment fund's average fair value over the the prior 5 years through the end of September preceding the fiscal year in which the distribution is planned. In establishing this policy, the Foundation considered the long-term expected return on its endowment. Accordingly, over the long term, the Foundation expects the current spending policy to allow its endowment to grow at the rate of inflation annually. This is consistent with the Foundation's objective to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment assets held in perpetuity as well as to provide additional real growth through new gifts and investment return.

Note 6 - Fair Value Measurements

The Fair Value Measurement and Disclosure Topic 820, section 50 of the Codification establishes a framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under ASC 820-50 are described as follows:

Level 1 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted market prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the plan has the ability to access,

Level 2 Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted market prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets
- Inputs rather than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability; and,
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at June 30, 2014 and 2013.

<u>Investment Securities</u> – The fair value of investment securities including the Bank Trusts investments is the fair market value based on quoted market prices, where available, or NAV or its equivalent as provided by the administrators of each underlying fund.

Money market/certificate of deposit – The fair value of money market accounts and certificates of deposit are amounts payable on demand at the reporting date. The fair value is based on the present value of each through their respective maturities.

<u>Contribution Receivable from Unitrust</u> and <u>Gift Annuity Liability</u> – The fair value of these agreements is based on the present value of the estimated future payments based upon management's assumptions.

The preceding methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Foundation believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

Note 8 - Gift Annuity Agreements

In prior years, the Foundation entered into gift annuity agreements with Kitty DeGree. As part of those agreements, Ms. DeGree made cumulative irrevocable contributions to the Foundation of \$500,000. The Foundation was required to make quarterly payments to her for the rest of her life. Ms. DeGree died in

October, 2012 and the balance of the annuity corpus (\$325,807) was transferred to the general assets of the Foundation in fiscal 2013.

In October 2005, the Foundation entered into a gift annuity agreement with Paul and Carolyn Lasseigne. As part of the agreement, Mr. and Mrs. Lasseigne gave an irrevocable contribution to the Foundation of \$10,000.

Additional contributions can be added to the principal. The Foundation is required to make quarterly payments to them at an annual rate of 5.6% on the cumulative principal balance. These payments will be required for the rest of both of their lives. At the death of both donors, the balance of the annuity corpus will be transferred to the College of Pharmacy Agency fund within the Foundation.

In April 2012, the Foundation entered into a gift annuity agreement with John and Billie Smith. As part of the agreement, Mr. and Mrs. Smith gave an irrevocable contribution to the Foundation of \$250,000. Additional contributions can be added to the principal. The Foundation is required to make quarterly payments to them at an annual rate of 5.6% on the cumulative principal balance. These payments will be required for the rest of both of their lives. At the death of both donors, the balance of the annuity corpus will be transferred to the general assets of the Foundation.

At the end of each fiscal year, the related annuity liability is calculated, and the Foundation adjusts the value accordingly. At June 30, 2014 and 2013, the Foundation included the following as an annuity liability.

During the 1992 regular session of the Louisiana Legislature, R.S.17:3384 and R.S.17:3129.5 were amended and reenacted to enable nonprofit organizations of a type described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to enter into a contract with a public institution of higher education to act as a depository for Endowed Chairs, Endowed Professorships and Endowed Scholarships derived from state matching funds. For the year ended June 30, 2014 and for the year ended June 30, 2013, the Foundation recognized \$0 and \$200,000, respectively, in state matching funds. Total state matching funds as of June 30, 2014 and 2013 were \$5,280,000 and \$5,280,000, respectively and local matching funds were \$8,100,000 and \$7,980,000, respectively, and are reflected under Funds Held as Agent on the Statement of Financial Position.

Note 11 - Endowments

Permanently restricted net assets at June 30, 2014 and 2013 consists of endowments established in 1970 to support scholarships and programs at the Univeristy of Louisana at Monroe. Contributions to the endowment funds are subject to donor restrictions that stipulate the original gift is to be held and invested by the Foundation indefinitely. Income derived from the fund, as prescribed the investment policy statement, is to be expended as prescribed by the donor.

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the University of Louisiana at Monroe Foundation (the Foundation) and the University of Louisiana at Monroe (the University), and the University of Louisiana System, solely to assist you in evaluating compliance with the University of Louisiana System *Policy on University Foundations and Other Affiliate Organizations* (the Policy) for the year ended June 30, 2014. The Foundation is responsible for ensuring compliance with the Policy. This engagement to apply agreed-upon procedures was performed in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of the parties specified in the report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Our procedures and findings are as follows:

Verify the Foundation did not make loans to or allocate any net earnings or assets to the benefit of its directors, officers or other private persons and that any payments made to these persons were for reasonable compensation for services rendered or reimbursement for reasonable travel expenses.

No exceptions noted as a result of the above procedure.

Verify that the Foundation made no political contributions nor reimbursed any employee for politically-related expenses that would violate IRS guidelines for 501(c)(3) organizations.

No exceptions noted as a result of the above procedure.

Verify that the funds for supplemental compensation and/or benefits for a UL System or University employee were paid to the System Office or University for disbursement to the employee; no supplemental payments were made directly to an employee unless specifically approved by the Board Office or University.

No exceptions noted as a result of the above procedure.

Verify that on a quarterly basis the Foundation reported to the University all single payments of \$1,000 or more made to or on behalf of any individual university employee.

There were 5 exceptions of payments to University employees that were not submitted to the University.
