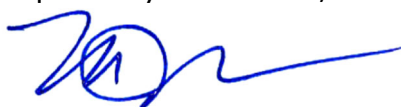

Summary

The purpose of this report is to summarize information provided to the Division of Administration (Division) by boards, commissions, and like entities (Boards). Louisiana Revised Statute (R.S.) 24:513.2(E) requires the Legislative Auditor to submit annually to the Legislature a report containing summary financial information and personnel data on Boards included in the database. The statute provides for the Legislative Auditor to report findings and recommendations resulting from an analysis of the information. Our findings and recommendations are categorized as follows:

- **Boards & Commissions Website** – The Boards & Commissions website is located at <https://wwwcfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsandcommissions/home.cfm>. The accuracy of the information available is solely dependent upon the timeliness and accuracy of the Boards' data entry.
- **Number of Boards Reported** – As of June 30, 2026, the website contained information on 492 Boards, which is a net increase of three from the previous year.
- **Boards Providing No Response** – We identified one Board that did not respond to requests for personnel data and financial information. The Division sent notices of noncompliance to the respective legislative committees as required by R.S. 49:1301. The Legislature may wish to consider taking action against Boards that fail to comply with the reporting requirements in state law.
- **Inactive Boards** – We identified 15 inactive Boards that do not appear to be fulfilling their established functions. Ten of these inactive Boards were also identified as inactive in the prior year. We recommend that the Legislature consider abolishing these Boards or taking other actions (additional legislation, appropriations, or board appointments) to assist them in fulfilling their established function.
- **Board Activity** – We identified 22 Boards that reported their status as active but have not reported any meeting notices or minutes subsequent to December 31, 2022. Also, five of these Boards have no board members identified on the website. We recommend that the Division

continue to work with these Boards to ensure they are appropriately reporting their status and complying with the reporting requirements in state law to make their meeting notices and minutes available on the website.

- **Board Per Diem, Salaries, and Travel Expenses** – For fiscal year 2026, Boards budgeted approximately \$1.3 million for Board member per diems, \$2.5 million for Board member salaries, and \$2.4 million for Board member travel expenses.

Boards & Commissions Website

R.S. 49:1301 requires the Commissioner of Administration to establish and maintain a website containing information on Boards:

The accuracy of each Board's self-reported information available on this website is solely dependent upon the timeliness and accuracy of each Board's data entry. As a result, anyone attempting to access information about current budgets or expenses for a specific Board may instead retrieve information that is outdated or inaccurate. Act 374 of the 2025 Regular Legislative Session, effective on July 1, 2027, makes changes to the Commissioner of Administration's requirements regarding the noted website and makes changes to the entities that are required to report information for inclusion.

We recommend that the Division continue to work with our office regarding the identification of Boards to be added or removed from the database and the form and content of the database fields. We are available to meet with the Division to discuss updates and/or improvements to the website database.

Number of Boards Reported

As of June 30, 2026, the website contains information on 492 Boards (see Appendix B), which is a net increase of three from the previous year. This net figure reflects the addition of 13 Boards and the removal of 10 Boards.

The 13 Boards added include 11 new Boards created during the 2025 legislative sessions and two existing Boards not previously included in the database. One of the Boards does not meet the criteria requiring reporting in the database; however, the Board requested that they be included. Boards added to the database during the year ended June 30, 2026, are as follows: Acadiana Regional Airport & the LeMaire Memorial Airport District; Alzheimer's and Related Dementias Advisory Council;

Baton Rouge Regional Airport Authority; Claiborne Parish Airport District No.31; Coordinated Use of Resources, Economy, Navigation & Transportation Authority Board; Cross Gates Subdivision Crime Prevention & Neighborhood Improvement District; Cypress Point Improvement District; Greater St. Martinville Economic Development District; Hotel Francis District; Lakewood Crime Prevention & Improvement District; Railroad Avenue Historic Cultural Economic District; Shreveport I-20 Economic Development District; and St. Martin Parish Economic and Industrial Development District.

The 10 Boards removed were abolished during the 2025 Regular Legislative Session. Boards removed from the database during the year ended June 30, 2026, are as follows: Advisory Council on Student Behavior and Discipline; Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission; Environmental Education Commission; Nursing Supply and Demand Council; Oil Spill Interagency Council; Oilfield Site Restoration Commission; Simulation Medical Training and Education Council for Louisiana; Water Management Advisory Task Force; Water Resources Commission; and West Feliciana Parish Port Commission.

The effects of the laws enacted during the 2026 Regular Legislative Session are not reflected in the database as of June 30, 2026. Any new or abolished Boards resulting from the 2026 Regular Legislative Session will be added or removed prior to the 2027 reporting period.

Boards Providing No Response

R.S. 24:513.2(F) directs all agencies, boards, commissions, and departments of the state and its political subdivisions to furnish information and reports as requested by the Legislative Auditor to fulfill his responsibilities. All Boards were requested to provide contact information, membership information, and statutory or legal authority relative to the entity.

R.S. 39:1335 and 1336 require licensing agencies to provide summary and detailed information pertaining to actual and budgeted revenues by source, expenditures by category, and fund balances; performance indicators; and certain general information pertaining to the Board and its authority and functions.

All other Boards were requested to provide similar information, except that the financial and budget information was requested in summary form only, and information pertaining to performance indicators was not requested.

As of June 30, 2026, the following Board did not respond to requests for personnel data and financial information.

1. Glen Oaks Area Crime Prevention and Improvement District *

Purpose or function:	To promote and improve the subdivisions of the Glen Oaks Area and North Baton Rouge, to provide a conduit for citizens and residents to help in the collective efforts of improving our area. To meet the security and beautification standards of all residents within the Crime Prevention and Improvement District (CPID). To institute programs for youth and young adults of the CPID.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9097.39
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.

** Board also did not respond to requests in the prior year.*

A joint letter from the Commissioner of Administration and the Legislative Auditor requesting information was mailed to all Boards identified in our report (Appendix B). Numerous requests to the Board listed above were made by the Division's staff to submit the requested information in the database.

In accordance with R.S. 49:1301, the Division sent notices of noncompliance to the Board for failure to respond to its requests. In addition, notice of the Board's failure to respond was sent to the state department of which the Board is a part, the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs, the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, and the oversight committees for the Board. The Legislature may wish to consider taking action against the Board for failure to comply with the reporting requirements in state law.

Inactive Boards

The following 15 Boards were created by the Legislature prior to the 2025 Legislative Session and were inactive, not/never fully organized, or disbanded as of June 30, 2026, due to the reasons below, which were obtained from the Board's representative or other relevant party, if applicable. Ten of these Boards were also inactive during the prior year. Because these Boards do not appear to be fulfilling their established functions, the Legislature should consider abolishing them or taking other actions (additional legislation, appropriations, or board appointments) to assist them in fulfilling their established function.

1. Advisory Committee for the Regulation and Control of Water Well Drillers

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	The committee serves in an advisory capacity and makes recommendations to the Office of Conservation on the licensing, qualifications and standards of conduct for those engaged in the business of drilling, or those abandoning, water wells and bore holes in the state.
Year created:	1982
Legal authority:	R.S. 38:3098.6
Date of last meeting:	May 5, 2026
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	The Louisiana Department of Conservation and Energy no longer has jurisdiction over the water well driller's licensing program, which transferred to the Louisiana State Licensing Board of Contractors. Because of this, the Board decided to place itself into an inactive status.

2. Bi-State Corridor Commission *

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To provide an information forum on the construction, expansion, improvement, or extension of a route designated U.S. 371, including the four-lane improvements or any portion thereof within the boundaries of the district; the construction of bridges, overpasses, causeways, underpasses, traffic circles, interchanges, and landscaping relating thereto; and the long-term economic/industrial development and tourism development of the corridor area.
Year created:	1991
Legal authority:	R.S. 48:1701
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, commission has no appointed members and there is no record of the commission ever meeting. Recommended the authorizing legislation be repealed.

3. Brookstown Area Crime Prevention and Improvement District

Status:	Never Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To provide great reduction in crime activity along with added community tranquility. To improve the aesthetics of the political subdivision by establishing landscaping on public properties and blighted properties in an effort to eliminate and prevent blight recurrence and to promote positive businesses in the district, encouraging positive multi-culturalism in the district.
Year created:	2024
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9097.41
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No board member appointments have been made yet.

4. Castle Manor Improvement District

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To promote beautification and security projects within the Castle Manor Improvement District neighborhood
Year created:	2024
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9091.28
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Special assessment property tax was voted on twice and failed to pass. Due to a lack of funding and a lack of interest or support from members and neighbors the district is considered to be inactive.

5. Coastal Louisiana Levee Consortium

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	The consortium shall facilitate communication and coordination of efforts of the levee districts and parishes in coastal south Louisiana and increase awareness of conditions and issues facing the coastal levee systems.
Year created:	2014
Legal authority:	R.S. 49:214.6.8
Date of last meeting:	December 14, 2022
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Due to the legislatively-required membership, a quorum for meetings has been difficult to establish. This issue has prevented the Board from holding a meeting. Recommended the authorizing legislation be repealed.

6. Dew Drop-America's Rock and Roll Museum Governing Board *

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To oversee the Dew Drop-America's Rock and Roll Museum.
Year created:	2022
Legal authority:	R.S. 25:380.41 – 380.45
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No update was provided for the current year, same as noted in the prior-year report.

7. LaSalle Cultural Corridor District *

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To promote, encourage, and enhance the cultural and economic assets of the district through renewed commerce, industry, and utilization and development of the human resources of the area.
Year created:	2022
Legal authority:	R.S. 25:850.21
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	No update was provided for the current year, same as noted in the prior-year report.

8. Medical Disclosure Panel *

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To determine which risks and hazards related to medical care and surgical procedures must be disclosed by a physician or other health care provider to a patient or person authorized to consent for a patient and to establish the general form and substance of such disclosure.
Year created:	2012
Legal authority:	R.S. 40:1157.2
Date of last meeting:	March 27, 2015
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, the Board is currently being reinstated; however, is having difficulties getting members from the various associations to submit their designees. This issue has prevented the panel from holding a meeting.
Recent legislative activity:	Board was originally included in House Bill 861 of the 2026 Regular Legislative Session for abolishment; however, the board was removed from the bill before final passage.

9. Morehouse Parish Lake Commission *

Status:	Disbanded
Purpose or function:	Develop a reservoir to provide potable water to Morehouse Parish.
Year created:	2003
Legal authority:	R.S. 38:3087.211
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Other information:	As was noted in the prior-year report, in 2019, the commission changed its status to "disbanded," and no Board members or contacts are currently provided in the database.

10. North Bossier Levee and Drainage District Board of Commissioners *

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To maintain the existing levee system in a condition that will ensure the integrity and safety to withstand river stages anticipated by design and construction.
Year created:	2009
Legal authority:	R.S. 38:291(J); R.S. 38:301.1
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, during the 2016 Regular Session, Senate Bill No. 148 included language to abolish the board; however, prior to the passage of the bill, the language to abolish the Board was removed. Therefore, the Board still exists, but there are no members.

11. Plank Road Business Economic Development Board *

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	Developing the area included within the district in order to provide for substantial economic activity and employment opportunities.
Year created:	2021
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:2740.67.1
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, Board has only had one meeting at which officers were selected. Since that time, the Board has not met again, nor have members that have left the Board since been replaced. It is the intent of the Board to reorganize and move forward with the business of the Board.

12. Small Business Compliance Advisory Panel *

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To provide advisory opinions to the Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) on the effectiveness of the Small Business Stationary Source Technical and Environmental Compliance Assistance Program.
Year created:	1992
Legal authority:	R.S. 30:2062
Date of last meeting:	August 10, 2011
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, lack of board member appointments. LDEQ wants to move forward and hopes to have a fully-functioning advisory panel once the necessary appointments have been made.

13. St. Martin Special Medical District *

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	To provide for cooperative economic development within the district among the district, the owner or owners of business and property within the district, and any other interested parties, such development endeavors being related to the provisions and expansion of medical services, renovation, restoration, and related ventures.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9038.75
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	As was noted in the prior-year report, board has not been organized.

14. State Use Council for Purchase of Goods and Services by Individuals with Disabilities *

Status:	Inactive
Purpose or function:	To coordinate and facilitate the provisions of R.S. 38:2261, which are to ensure state agencies give preference in its purchasing practices to goods manufactured and services performed by individuals with disabilities through supported employment providers, provided such goods manufactured or services performed are equal in quality and reasonable in the rate charged based upon those goods and services available from other providers.
Year created:	2019
Legal authority:	R.S. 39:1604.4
Date of last meeting:	March 8, 2021
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Board is currently listed as inactive while Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) reviews the appropriateness of continuing the program. Changes to the program require legislative action, and LDH will pursue changes during future Legislative Sessions.
Recent legislative activity:	House Bill 773 of the 2026 Regular Legislative Session included language to repeal the statute creating the board. No final action was taken by the legislature on this bill.

15. University Security District

Status:	Not Fully Organized
Purpose or function:	The purpose of the district is to aid in crime prevention and to add to the security of district residents by providing for an increase in the presence of law enforcement personnel in the district and to serve the needs of the residents of the district by funding beautification and improvements for the overall betterment of the district.
Year created:	2023
Legal authority:	R.S. 33:9097.37
Date of last meeting:	No record of meetings posted in database.
Reason for inactivity provided by Board representative:	Board has not been organized.

**These Boards were also identified as inactive in the prior year.*

The following Boards with an inactive status were included in the database as of June 30, 2026 (see Appendix B) and were abolished by 2026 legislation. Board Activity

A Board that has not held meetings for an extended period of time may indicate that the Board is not fulfilling its established function(s) or is no longer necessary. R.S. 49:1302 requires notices and minutes of board meetings to be included on the Boards & Commissions website. The Division has requested all Boards to either post their meeting notices and minutes directly to the Boards & Commissions website or provide a link to meeting notices and minutes that are posted on the Board's own website.

Based on our review of the 460 Boards with a reported status of active, we identified 22 Boards as listed on the following page that have not reported any meeting notices or minutes subsequent to December 31, 2022. Also, five of these Boards have no board members identified on the website. We recommend the Division continue to work with these Boards to ensure all Boards are appropriately reporting their status and complying with the reporting requirements to make their meeting notices and minutes available on the Boards & Commission website.

Board Per Diem, Salaries, and Travel Expenses

Of the 492 Boards listed in Appendix B, we identified 140 Boards with budgeted payments for Board member per diem, salaries, and/or travel expenses based solely on the information available in the database. The budget amounts presented below in Exhibit 1 reflect the fiscal year 2026 current budget amounts entered in the database by the Boards during the 2026 reporting period unless otherwise indicated. Boards have until May 1, 2027, to enter fiscal year 2027 budgets and fiscal year 2026 actual expenses in the database.
